

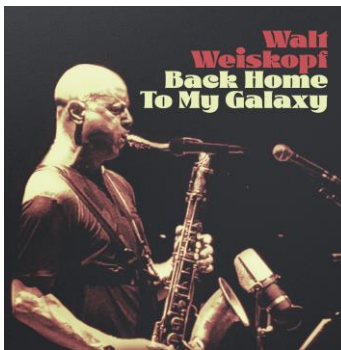

Critically-acclaimed American jazz saxophonist Walt Weiskopf to digitally release re-mastered 1992 recordings



New York, NY. – American saxophonist, composer, author and producer Walt Weiskopf, in conjunction with AMM Records, announces his extended play, digital release of “Back Home to My Galaxy,” the original recordings of a now re-mastered project recorded in 1992 at the Steve Davis Studio in Brooklyn, New York, USA.

Joined by Andy Fusco (alto saxophone) – deceased; brother Joel Weiskopf (piano); Conrad Herwig (trombone); Jay Anderson (bass); and Steve Davis (drums), “Back Home To My Galaxy” includes four tracks composed by Weiskopf exclusively:

Track 1: “Ritual;” Track 2: “Back Home To My Galaxy;” Track 3: “True Lovers;” Track 4: “Hand To Mouth”

“True Lovers” will be released digitally as a single on January 19, 2024. The full EP will be released on February 23, 2024. Both releases can be found on all digital platforms (i.e., Spotify, Apple, etc.).

“It was a gift to discover these thirty-year-old vintage tracks,” says Weiskopf about this project. “I was surprised at the quality of the fidelity, and the performances are really very good.”

About Walt Weiskopf:

With critically-acclaimed albums and countless sideman credits, Walt started his career with the Buddy Rich band at the age of 21. In the years since, he has released more than 25 CDs featuring a stellar cast of the best contemporary jazz musicians including Brad Mehldau, John Pattituci, Joe Magnarelli, Renee Rosnes, Joe Locke, Conrad Herwig, Peter Zak, Billy Drummond, and Peter Washington, to name a few. Since 2017, Walt has been focused on leading his European Quartet (featuring pianist Carl Winther, bassist Andreas Lang and Anders Mogensen on drums), having recently released their fifth album, “Harmless Addiction” on AMM Records. For over 20 years, Weiskopf continues to be a member of the Steely Dan band which is currently performing with the Eagles’ “Long Goodbye” Tour.
