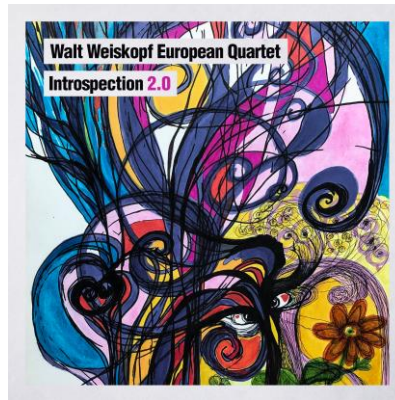

**Walt Weiskopf European Quartet announces “Introspection 2.0” album  
First digital single set to release today**



*New York, NY.* – American saxophonist, composer and author Walt Weiskopf announces the digital release of part two of the Walt Weiskopf European Quartet (WWEQ) album, “Introspection 2.0.” As an extension to their “Introspection” 2020 album, “Introspection 2.0” continues the harmonic journey with six additional tracks, including three singles that will be digitally released throughout the remainder of this year.

The upcoming releases, from [Believe Digital](https://www.believedigital.com), begin today with the single “Pure Imagination”; followed by the single “When Your Lover Has Gone” on August 20; and the up-tempo, Weiskopf original composition “Serpentine” on September 17.

Scheduled for release on October 15, 2021, the full 12-track album features pianist Carl Winther, bassist Andreas Lang and drummer Anders Mogensen, and three more original compositions by Weiskopf himself. Recorded remotely in three different locations: Richmond, Virginia (Weiskopf); Copenhagen, Denmark (Mogensen and Winther); and Berlin, Germany (Lang) from January to March 2021, all releases can be found on Spotify, Amazon, Qobuz, iTunes, and Google PLAY on the dates listed above.

Says Weiskopf about the remote recording experience, “To be able to continue making music and bring it to the people who love music despite the limits of travel and proximity, is ultimately very empowering and gratifying.”

A 2022 WWEQ tour of the album is intended from mid-January through mid-February.

**About Walt Weiskopf:**

With critically-acclaimed albums and countless sideman credits, Weiskopf started his career with the Buddy Rich band at the age of 21. In the years since, he has released more than 20 CDs featuring a stellar cast of the best contemporary jazz musicians including Brad Mehldau, John Pattitucci, Joe Magnarelli, Renee Rosnes, Joe Locke, Conrad Herwig, Peter Zak, Billy Drummond, and Peter Washington to name a few. For 17 years, Weiskopf continues to be an active member of the Steely Dan band.
